# DESCRIPTION

**SCREEN PRINTING**, LIKE ANY ART AND DESIGN TECHNIQUE, CAN SERVE A SPECIFIC DISCURSIVE AND POLITICAL PURPOSE. IN THIS WORKSHOP, WE WILL EXPLORE THE TRANSLATION OF SEX-DISSIDENT NARRATIVES INTO ELOQUENT AND INCISIVE DESIGNS, WHICH CAN IN TURN BE APPLIED THROUGH SCREEN PRINTING ON TEXTILE AND PAPER SUPPORTS.

GUIDED BY SILUSTRA, DESIGNER OF L'ARRAVALERA'S GRAPHIC IDENTITY, AND ANDRE GAETANO, DESIGNER OF METZINERES' GRAPHIC IDENTITY, PARTICIPANTS WILL DEVELOP A SPECIFIC DESIGN THAT WILL LATER BE PRINTED ON TOTE BAGS, T-SHIRTS, AND/OR POSTERS AT SUBURBIA PRINTSHOP. AS PART OF THE GROUP DYNAMIC, WE WILL ALSO DEVISE A POSSIBLE COLLECTIVE URBAN INTERVENTION STRATEGY TO MAKE THE MESSAGES AND FINAL DESIGNS VISIBLE.

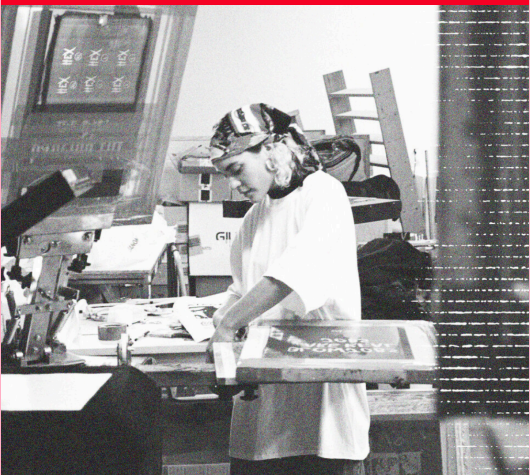
## ANDRE GAETANO
